

**Looking for candidates for the national selection contest for
Permanent Researchers at the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS), France**

In order to strengthen the activities of the DM3 department (*Design of Materials, Membranes and Multifunctional Systems - MCP Team*) at the Institut Européen des Membranes de Montpellier (France), we would like to recruit a **permanent Research Fellow in the Section 15 ("Material Chemistry, Nanomaterials and Processes") of the CNRS**, on the following theme:

***Design and manufacture of ceramic, hybrid and composite
multifunctional membranes for applications in extreme conditions***

The candidates will have to prepare a targeted project of ~10 pages, consistent with this rather broad theme and integrating their specific skills. As this competition is very selective, only candidates who have stayed out from France for their Post-Doc or their PhD studies will be selected for an oral presentation. Candidates have to be familiar with French language and preferably less than 32 years old.

Candidates interested in preparing the 2021 contest on this topic are invited to contact quickly Dr. Anne JULBE in order to check their eligibility, exchange on their project and prepare the application (to be submitted in January 2021).
